A database of UK and Irish company information and business intelligence

fame combines comprehensive, and detailed company information with flexible software. Using it you can create searches and analyse your results. *fame* contains current and historical information on nearly nine million companies.

Company information

The company information on Fame can be broken down as follows:

- 2 million companies in a detailed format
- 200,000 companies in a summary format
- Nearly 1 million companies that are active but not required to file accounts or have yet to file their first accounts
- 5.2 million companies that are no longer active. These are included so you can research patterns in default and confirm previous existence
- Up to ten years of history per company

Additional business intelligence

As well as company financials, Fame has business and company news, industry research, credit scores and ratings, financial strength indicators, corporate CCJs, directors and additional contacts, images of original (scanned) filings and detailed corporate structures. You can create your own ratios within Fame for advanced analysis.

- Find companies that match your profiles including size, industry and location
- Find all companies in the same corporate "family" and look at complex organisational structures in clear diagrams. This unique data set includes international and domestic ownership information
- Compile a detailed picture of a company that includes background information, financial history plus relevant news, M&A deals and rumours

- Monitor companies and peer groups you're interested in using Fame's flexible alerts
- Export your results for analysis or business development projects

The reports and the information they contain

Fame contains very detailed information on companies with up to 10 years of history per company.

- Company name, previous company name(s), registered number, registered office address, phone, web address, primary and trading addresses and phone numbers
- Trade description, primary and secondary SIC codes (UK 2007), brand names and major sectors, US SIC, NAICS and NACE codes, standard peer group
- Bankers, auditors, previous auditors, audit details including indicators of qualified/unqualified accounts, a post balance sheet event, audit exemption and contingent liabilities
- Number of employees
- Company type, date of incorporation, filing changes, accounting reference date, company status

Quoted companies

Main exchange and ticker symbol, security and price information, LSE indices, current and annual stock data and valuations, daily, weekly and monthly pricing series, market capitalisation figures and advisors.

Financial information

The accounts are in a detailed standardised format and contain a maximum of:

- 63 profit and loss items
- 74 balance sheet items
- 10 cash flow items
- 28 financial and profitability ratios plus financial trends and changes

Financial strength

Credit scores, and ratings, for all available years. Gazette data, six years of CCJ history and mortgage data.

M&A data

Comprehensive deals and rumours from our Zephyr database. You can use various criteria to search for companies involved in deals.

News

Up-to-the-minute news from major providers. The news is fully searchable and stories are linked to individual companies.

Customising/own data

- Create your own financial items and ratios
- Add company reports containing your own figures – ideal for benchmarking against modelled accounts
- Create modified versions of existing accounts or append with extra years – ideal for forecasting
- Append existing records with your own data fields (text or numerical)

Information on individuals

Fame includes information on directors, shareholders, heads of department plus other senior contacts. Information includes current and previous directors with dates of birth, appointment dates, position, gender, nationality, other directorships, an indicator if they are a shareholder in the company, directors' remuneration and highest paid director. Contacts have address, position and function/type.

Original documents

Images of original documents such as the annual return, annual accounts, documents of incorporation, changes in director/secretary, special resolution, liquidator's account, increase in capital, memorandum and articles plus others, as filed at Companies House and the Companies Registration Office in Ireland.

Corporate structures

Our ownership data is collated and researched in house and is exclusive to BvD

- Numbers and details of domestic and international holdings and subsidiaries
- List of all shareholders for non-quoted companies
- List of shareholders down to 0.1% of ownership for quoted companies
- Direct and indirect ownership, global and domestic ultimate owner, independence indicator, ownership history, corporate families (all companies with the same parent)

Bespoke overviews

For many companies Fame includes detailed textual information on what a company does beyond traditional trade descriptions.

Industry research

Industry profile reports and company reports associated with a company's activities or brands from MarketLine (Datamonitor).

Reports are not always fully populated – either because items are not filed or because we are not able to publish data for legal reasons.

Not all information is provided in the standard subscription but via additional paid modules.

Searching Fame

You can search Fame by any combination of hundreds of criteria and build searches to find companies with very specific profiles. You can even search by criteria you've created yourself.

Flexible reporting

You can build reports section-by-section, or by line item, to contain the exact content you want. You can also include Fame's graphs in your reports.

Analyse

Fame's integrated software helps you create sophisticated analyses of just one company or a group of companies. You can segment a group of companies by two variables of your choice, aggregate accounts and create peer analyses.

Export

You can export the reports, graphs and analyses into most packages for further analysis or to include in your presentations.
